Summer Wind

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

White or off-white background:

2 ea. 6-3/4" squares for HSTs. 8 ea. 3" squares for FGs.

HSTs = Half Square Triangles

FGs = Flying Geese

Color fabrics:

Color A - 2 ea. 6-3/4" squares for HSTs

1 ea 4-1/2" square for center

Color B - 1 ea 5-1/2" squares for FGs

Color C - 1 ea 5-1/2" squares for FGs

Color D - 4 ea. 2-1/2" squares

Cut line Sew line


SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:

Half Square Triangles (HSTs)

- 1. On wrong side of each 6-3/4" background square, draw two diagonal lines (x).
- 2. Place one background square on to one Color A square, right sides together.
- 3. Sew 1/4" on both sides of both lines (x).
- 4. Cut in half top to bottom and left to right (+). (See Picture 2)
- 5. Cut on diagonal lines (x) to make eight half-square triangles.
- 6. Repeat steps 1-5 to make 16 HSTs. Note: You will have four extra HSTs for another project.
- 7. Press the half-square triangles to the color side, and using the diagonal line on your ruler, square up each one to 2-1/2".

Flying Geese (FGs)


- 1. Use the "four-at-a-time" method to make the eight flying geese for this block.
- 2. Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, on each of the eight 3" background squares.
- 3. Place one background square, right side down, on lower left-hand corner of each of the Color B and Color C, 5-1/2" squares. Place the other background square on the upper right-hand side of each color square
- 4. Sew 1/4" on either side of the lines, and through both background squares of both color fabrics. (See Picture 3)

- 5. Cut on the diagonal lines to make two halves. Press to the color side. (See Picture 4)
- 6. Place a background square, diagonally, on to lower half of each half. (See Picture 4). Sew 1/4" on each side of the diagonal line.
- 7. Cut along the drawn line and press. Square up each FG to 2-1/2" x 4-1/2".

Assemble the HSTs, FGs, and pieces into the "Summer Wind" 12-1/2" block. (See Picture 1) Note: the white sections of the HSTs face the outer edge of this block.
