
## Santa Rosa Quilt Guild March, 2011 Block of the Month

due Thursday, April 7, 2011



Block Name: Super Simple Springtime Square-in-a-Square

Finished Size: 8" square

Fabrics: Two 5" squares Springtime flowers
Two 5" squares off-white background

Make two sets of triangle squares, as follows:

Place 5" squares of flowery fabric and 5" squares of background fabric right sides together with the light fabric on top. Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of light fabric, and stitch 1/4" seams along both sides of drawn line, 1/4" away from the line. Cut triangles apart on the drawn pencil line. Press seams of two triangles toward light fabric and seams of two triangles toward darker fabric. Trim to accurate 4-1/2" squares.

## Following the diagrams:

Stitch two triangles together to form top row, and press seam to one side. Stitch second set of triangles together to form bottom row, and press seam to opposite side.

Join top and bottom rows together to finish
Springtime Square in a Square, 8-1/2" unfinished.
