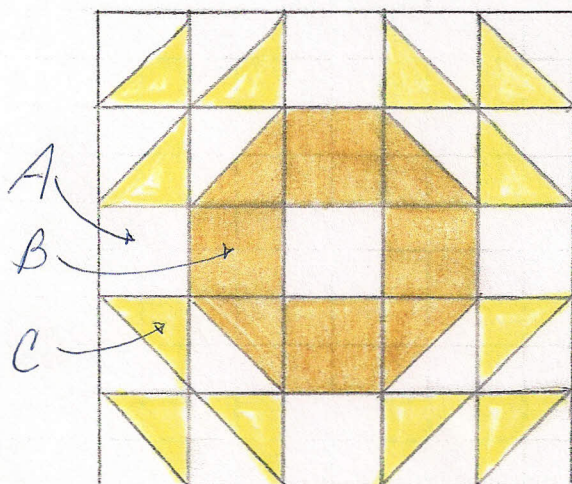
Block Name: Wedding Ring

Finished Size: 10" square

Fabric A: pale off-white
8 squares, 3" x 3"
5 squares, 2-1/2" x 2-1/2"

Fabric B: gold floral
2 squares, 3" x 3"
4 squares, 2-1/2" x 2-1/2"

Fabric C: gold flecks
6 squares, 3" x 3"



Place a 3" Fabric A square together with a 3" Fabric B square right sides together with the light fabric on top. Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of light fabric, and stitch along both sides of drawn line, 1/4" away from the line. Cut triangles apart on the drawn pencil line. Repeat to create four A/B triangle squares. TRIM to accurate 2-1/2" square.

Next, using six 3" squares of Fabric A and six 3" squares of Fabric C, create twelve triangle squares. TRIM to accurate 2-1/2" square.

Press all seams toward the darker fabrics. Following the diagram, join squares together to form five rows. Press seams of each row in opposite directions.

Stitch rows together to complete
Wedding Ring Block, 10-1/2" unfinished.
