Block-of-the-Month

"Flock Block"

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

White or off-white fabric

- ◆ 1 ea. 7" square
- ◆ 4 ea. 4" squares

Color fabric

- ◆ 1 ea. 7" square (color A)
- ◆ 4 ea. 4" squares (color B)

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS:

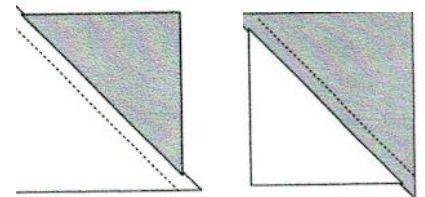
1. For all blocks, layer one white/off-white square and one color square, right sides together. Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, on the wrong side of the background square. Sew 1/4" on both sides of the line and cut corner to corner on drawn line. Press the 7" block's seams in opposite directions.
2. Press *six* of the 4" blocks to the darker side and *two* to the lighter side.
3. Trim the 7" blocks to 6-1/2". Trim the 4" blocks to 3-1/2".
4. Using the 3-1/2" blocks, make two four-patch blocks. Note the direction of the seam allowances.
5. Join one four-patch and one 6-1/2" block. Then join the other pair.
6. Attach the two block halves together, overlapping and matching seams so the seams will nest at the center. Press seam allowance to get the best look on the right side.

Arrange the four blocks as shown above, and sew them into a 12-1/2" block.

Note: Please write your name on a backside seam of each of the 12-1/2" blocks you make AND sign a ticket to put your name in for the drawing.

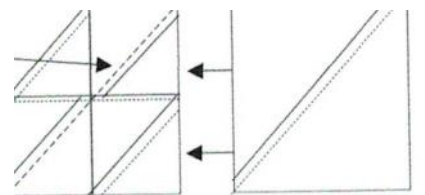

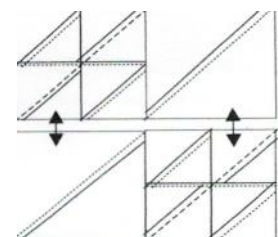
