

Block-of-the-Month for December 2024



The December Block of the Month, *Mondrian*, was designed by Jamie Moilanen. It is from the Modern Blocks quilt book compiled by Susanne Woods, published by C&T Publishing, and is available from our SRQG Library.

Fabric Choices and Cutting Instructions:

Fabric in Any Color and Print of Your Choice (I used strips in various colors)

Cut 1 square 5 inches by 5 inches for the center block (A).

Cut 1 rectangle 2.5 inches by 4.5 inches (M).

Cut 1 rectangle 2 inches by 8 inches (N).

Dark Charcoal or Black Fabric of Your Choice

Cut 2 strips 1 inch by 5 inches (B).

Cut 2 strips 1 inch by 6 inches (C).

Cut 2 strips 1 inch by 2 inches (D).

Cut 1 strip 1 inch by 2.5 inches (E).

Cut 1 strip 1 inch by 12.5 inches (F).

Cut 1 strip 1.5 inches by 12.5 inches (0).

For December we will go gray, just not all the way!

Gather your gray fabrics and pick out 3 prints of medium to light values.

First Gray Print of Your Choice

Cut 2 rectangles 2 inches by 3 inches (G). Cut 1 rectangle 3.25 inches by 9 inches (H).

Second Gray Print of Your Choice

Cut 2 rectangles 2 inches by 3 inches (I). Cut 1 rectangle 2.5 inches by 9 inches (J).


Third Gray Print of Your Choice

Cut 1 rectangle 9 inches by 2.25 inches (K).
Cut 1 strip 1 inch by 8 inches (L).

Sewing Instructions


Sew strip B to the left and right sides of the center A. Press.

Sew strip C to the top and bottom of center A. Press.



Sew strip D between rectangles I and G. Repeat to make the second unit.

Sew a completed rectangle to each vertical side of the center unit.




Sew rectangle H to the bottom of the center unit and rectangles

J and K to the top of the center unit you created above.

See the example on the left side below.

Sew rectangle F to the side of your unit. See the example on the right side below.




Sew rectangle L to the side of rectangle N. Sew rectangle E to the bottom of rectangle M.

Then sew this rectangle to the top of the L and N rectangle.

Add this unit to the unit completed above.

Sew rectangle O to the side of your unit.



Trim your block to 12.5 inches square and put your name on a seam on the backside of your block so you can be entered in the Block of the Month drawing. This drawing will be held at the first Thursday guild meeting in February.
