Block-of-the-Month for November 2024



The November Block of the Month, *Alleyways*, was designed by Weeks Ringle and Bill Kerr.

It is from the Modern Blocks quilt book compiled by Susanne Woods, published by

C&T Publishing, and is available from our SRQG Library.

Fabric Choices and Cutting Instructions:

Assorted Fabric of Your Choice in all Values

Cut 16 to 20 strips 7 inches long and approximately 1.5 inches wide at one end and 2.25 inches wide at the other end.

Gray or Off White Fabric of Your Choice

Cut 2 strips 1.5 inches by 6 inches.

Cut 1 strip 1.5 inches by 12.5 inches.

Sewing Instructions:

Use a 1/4 inch seam allowances.

From your 7 inch strip pile, sew 4 to 6 of these strips with right sides together.

Form a piece that is larger than 6.5 inches by 6.5 inches.

Press the seams open and trim the piece to 6 inches by 6 inches.

Repeat the above instructions to make 4 squares 6 inches by 6 inches.









Take two of your squares and put them in a vertical position (see the examples below).

Sew one of your 1.5 inch by 6 inch gray or off white fabric strips in the middle of your two vertical squares.

Repeat this instruction for the remaining two squares.





Sew the 1.5 inch by 12.5 inch gray or off white fabric strip between the two units created above to complete the block.



Trim your block to 12.5 inches square and put your name on a seam on the backside of your block so you can be entered in the Block of the Month drawing.

This drawing will be held at the first Thursday guild meeting in February.
