

Block-of-the-Month for October 2024

## Fabric Choices and Cutting Instructions:

## Fabric of Your Choice in a Dark Value

Cut 1 rectangle 5.5 inches by 2.5 inches (A1)

Cut 1 rectangle 2.5 inches by 3.5 inches (A3)

Cut 2 squares 2.5 inches (B2 and C2)

Cut 1 rectangle 5.5 inches by 2.5 inches (D1)

Cut 1 rectangle 2.5 inches by 3.5 inches (D3)

Fabric of Your Choice in a Light Value

Cut 1 rectangle 5.5 inches by 3.5 inches (B1)

Cut 1 rectangle 2.5 inches by 3.5 inches (B3)

Cut 2 squares 3.5 inches (A2 and D2)

Cut 1 rectangle 3.5 inches by 5.5 inches (C1)

Cut 1 rectangle 2.5 inches by 3.5 inches (C3)

## Sewing Instructions:

I had to take apart some of my combinations because I did not get the blocks lined up according to the design. Before sewing make sure the piece you are adding is in the proper area.

Create each unit (A, B, C, and D) by sewing together pieces 2 to 3, and then adding piece 1. Continue with the remaining 3 units.



Once your 4 units are complete, sew Unit A to Unit B and Unit C to Unit D.

Then sew the combined A and B units to the combined C and D units.



Remember to sew with right sides of the fabric together and to press seams. I did press my seams open for this block. Trim your block to 10.5 inches square. And last but not least, sign your name on a seam on the backside of your block. Without your name, your ticket cannot be completed for the drawing.
