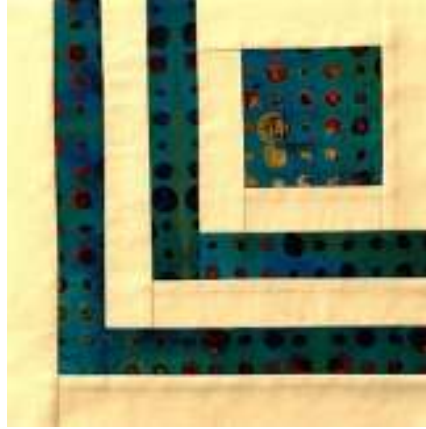


Santa Rosa Quilt Guild

Block-of-the-Month for September 2024



The September BOM was inspired by the *Diamond Ripples* block in the *Modern Blocks* quilt book compiled by Susanne Woods, published by C&T Publishing, and is available from our SRQG Library. The block was designed by Lara Finlayson, and I really tried to think of a way I could make it without making the required 36 half-square triangle units. Not successful with that so our BOM is more of a log cabin style.

Fabric Choices and Cutting Instructions:

Fabric of Your Choice in a Dark Value

Cut 1 square 3.5 inches by 3.5 inches (A)

Cut 1 rectangle 5.5 inches by 1.5 inches (C1)

Cut 1 rectangle 6.5 inches by 1.5 inches (C2)

Cut 1 rectangle 7.5 inches by 1.5 inches (E1)

Cut 1 rectangle 8.5 inches by 1.5 inches (E2)

Cream or Off-White Fabric

Cut 1 rectangle 3.5 inches by 1.5 inches (B1)

Cut 2 rectangles 4.5 inches by 1.5 inches (B2 and B3)

Cut 1 rectangle 5.5 inches by 1.5 inches (B4)

Cut 1 rectangle 6.5 inches by 1.5 inches (D1)

Cut 1 rectangle 7.5 inches by 1.5 inches (D2)

Cut 1 rectangle 8.5 inches by 1.5 inches (F1)

Cut 1 rectangle 9.5 inches by 1.5 inches (F2)

Sewing Instructions:



Sew the B1 strip to bottom of the A square.

Sew the B2 strip to the left side of the A square.

Sew the B3 strip to the top of the A square.

Sew the B4 strip to the right side of the A square.

Sew the C1 strip to the B1 strip at the bottom on the unit.

Sew the C2 strip to the B2 strip on the left side of the unit.

Sew the D1 strip to the C1 strip at the bottom of the unit.

Sew the D2 strip to the C2 strip on the left side of the unit.

Sew the E1 strip to the D1 strip at the bottom of the unit.

Sew the E2 strip to the D2 strip on the left side of the unit.

Sew the F1 strip to the E1 strip at the bottom of the unit.

And finally sew the F2 strip to the E2 strip on the left side of the unit.

Remember to sew with right sides of the fabric together and to press seams. I did press my seams to one side. Trim your block to 8 ½ inches square.

And last but not least, sign your name on a seam on the backside of your block. Without your name, your ticket cannot be completed for the drawing.
