

# Santa Rosa Quilt Guild **Block-of-the-Month April 2025**

"Morning Star"

## **Fabric**

White	Green print/solid	Blue Print
4 – 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles (B) 4 – 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles (C) 8 – 2-1/2" squares (E)	8 – 2-1/2" squares (G) 1 – 4-1/2" squares (H)	4 – 3-1/2" squares (A) 4 – 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles (D)

## **Sewing Directions:**

White

4 – 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles (F)

## Corner Units (A/B/C):

- 1. Sew one white 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangle (B) to one side of a blue 3-1/2" square (A).
- 2. Sew one white 1-1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangle (C) to the bottom of the unit.
- Repeat to make four corner units measuring 4-1/2" x 4-1/2".

## Blue Flying Geese Units (D/E):

- 1. On the wrong side of each white 2-1/2" square (E), draw a line from corner to corner.
- 2. Using the white (E) squares and the blue 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" (D) rectangles, make four flying geese units.
- Unit should measure 2-1/2" x 4-1/2".

### **Green Flying Geese Units (F/G)**

- 1. On the wrong side of each green 2-1/2" square (G), draw a line from corner to cor-
- 2. Using the green (G) squares and the white 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" (F) rectangles, make four flying geese units.
- 3. Unit should measure 2-1/2" x 4-1/2".

## Side Units (D/E/F/G)

- 1. Lay out one D/E flying geese unit and one F/G flying geese unit as shown.
- Sew together to make one side unit. Press seams open.
- Repeat to make four side units measuring 4-1/2" x 4-1/2".

#### Assembly:

- 1. Lay out the corner units, side units, and H square as shown in photo at top.
- 2. Join the units into rows, then sew the rows together to make the full block.

Block will measure 12-1/2" square.
