Fabric

White background

4 ea. 4-1/2” squares

**1 ea. 5-1/4” square
 (bisect on two diagonals)**

Color Fabric A (pink) and B (green)

6 ea. 2-1/2” squares

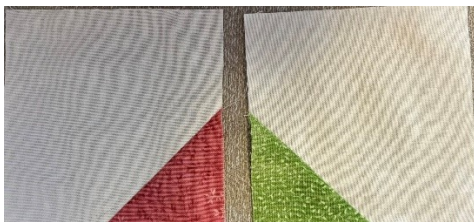
1 ea. 4-7/8” square (bisect on one diagonal)

Color Fabric C (pink and/or green floral)

1 ea. 5-1/4” square (bisect on two diagonals)

Sewing Directions:

Corner Squares – Draw a line corner to corner on two of the 2-1/2” squares of Fabric A. Sew to the corner of the 4-1/2” white square as shown in Picture 2. Repeat with Fabric B. Trim to 4-1/2”. You will have two of each color. Refer to Picture 1 above.

Center Side and Bottom Squares – Sew bisected white to bisected Fabric C as shown in Picture 3. Fabric C should be sewn to the left side on all pieces. Then sew bisected Fabric A to triangle unit to make a square as shown in Picture 4. Now sew bisected Fabric B to the corner of Fabric A as shown in Picture 5. Trim to 4-1/2”. Make four units.

Center square – Sew the remaining 2-1/2" squares of Fabric A and B to the corners of the 4-1/2" white square as shown in Picture 6. Trim to 4-1/2".

Putting it together:

Referring to Picture 1, sew the units into three rows.
Press the seam allowances towards the outside.
Sew the three rows together to complete the block.
Press the seam allowances toward the center of the block.

Unfinished size of block is 12 1/2". It is important to sew this block with a consistent 1/4" seam. This block is good for using your stash. Please print your name on a back side seam of each block you submit so you will be eligible to win more blocks. The drawing(s) will be held at our guild meeting on April 3.
