Block-of-the-Month

“Split Star”

Fabric

White background

- 1 – 7” square
- 1 – 4” square
- 5 – 3-1/2” squares
- 2 – 3-1/2” x 6-1/2” rectangles

Color Fabric (Dark Blue Print)

- 1 – 7” square
- 1 – 4” square
- 5 – 3-1/2” squares
- 2 – 3-1/2” x 6-1/2” rectangles

Sewing Directions:

1. Using the White and Blue 7” squares, sew together a large Half Square Triangle (HST) unit by drawing a line from corner to corner on the white square and sewing 1/4” on both sides of the line. Cut square 1/4” from sew lines. Trim/square up the unit to 6-1/2” square. You will wind up with two units, but you only need one per block.
2. Using the White and Blue 4” squares, repeat Step 1. Trim/square up the units to 3-1/2” square. You will use both small HST units.
3. Using four White 3-1/2” squares and two Blue 3-1/2” x 6-1/2” rectangles, sew together two Flying Geese units.
4. Repeat Step 3 only using the four Blue 3-1/2” squares and two White 3-1/2” x 6-1/2” rectangles.
5. Lay out the Half Square Triangle units, the Flying Geese units, the White 3-1/2” square, and the Blue 3-1/2” square as shown in the picture above.
6. Sew the units into three rows.
7. Press the seam allowances away from the Flying Geese units.
8. Sew the three rows together to complete the block.
9. Press the seam allowances toward the center of the block.

Unfinished size of block is 12-1/2”. It’s important to sew this block with a consistent 1/4” seam. This block is good for using your stash or a fat quarter. Please write your name on a back side seam of each block you submit so you’ll be eligible to win more blocks. The drawing(s) will be held at our guild meeting on March 6.
