
Churn Dash



3 Blocks x 4 Blocks with a 2" border makes a perfect Project Linus Quilt Sized Quilt!


This makes a 12"

** Supplies List **

Color 1 <u>Color 1 needs</u>: one 4-7/8" x 9-3/4" strip, one 2-1/2" x 18" AND one 4-1/2" square

Color 2

<u>Color 2 needs</u>: one 4-7/8" x 9-3/4" strip AND one 2-1/2" x 18" strip



Stack right sides together Color 1 and Color 2 4-7/8" x 9- 3/4" strips, and using a rotary cutter, cut these together into two 4-7/8" squares of each...



Draw diagonal line on the 4-7/8" squares.




Next, stitch using scant 1/4" seams on either side of line to form four of these half squares. Cut on line. Press seams towards darker fabrics. Trim to 4-1/2" if needed...

Traditional Block


Churn Dash



Then, right sides together, sew the two 2-1/2" x 18" strips along one long edge using scant 1/4" seams. Press seams towards darker fabrics...



Cut the resultant strip at 4-1/2" intervals into four 4-1/2" square pieced sections...





...and now sew all of these together, same 1/4" scant seams, in the order shown at left!
