December Block of the Month

Snowflake 12 ½"
Due January 4, 2007

Make in white on white fabric for background and ice blue for figure for the contest and a bright print with a kid friendly print in the center for the Community Quilts Project. Make one in your choice of fabrics for your sampler quilt.


Cutting instructions:

From fabric A (white on white background)
Cut four rectangles 2 ½" by 4 ½"
Cut one square 4 ½" by 4 ½"
Cut eight squares 2 ½" by 2 ½"
Cut four squares 2 7/8" by 2 7/8"
Cut these on the diagonal once -you need eight triangles

From fabric B (ice blue)
Cut four rectangles 2 ½" by 4 ½"
Cut four squares 2 ½" by 2 1/2"
Cut two squares 4 7/8" by 4 7/8"
Cut these on the diagonal once – you need four triangles

Sewing instructions:

- 1. To make corner units: Following diagram sew two 2 7/8" triangles of fabric A to two sides of 2 ½" by 2 ½" square of fabric B. Press seams to dark. To this sew a 4 7/8" triangle of fabric B (ice blue) matching points of the long side if the triangle being careful not to stretch the bias edge as you sew. Press seam to dark. Make four corner units.
- 2. To make side center units: Draw a diagonal line from upper left corner to lower right corner on each light fabric A 2 ½" by 2 ½" square. Place a square with right



sides together on a corner of one of the blue fabric B 2 ½" by 4 ½" rectangles. SEW ON LINE. Trim away underlying two layers. Press towards corner. Repeat with other corner. Repeat above steps until you have four flying geese units.

- 3. Sew flying goose unit to a fabric A rectangle. Repeat until you have four goose/rectangle units.
- Following the diagram sew corner units to side units and to center unit.
