This block is "Lady of the Lake."

It measures 12" finished (12-1/2" unfinished)

Twenty small half square triangle units surround one large half square triangle unit.



There are only two fabrics for each block - Fabric A is lighter, and Fabric B is darker.

Justine would like to have it in **contrasting shades of blue batiks** - any range of values is acceptable as long as there is contrast between the two fabrics.

Use your favorite method of constructing half-square triangle (HST) units, but this block will only come together if you measure each unit before you start assembling the block:

The small units are 2-1/2" unfinished.

The large unit is 8-1/2" unfinished.

(We are planning a TSW, June 7, on various methods of constructing HST units.) If you would like to paper piece your rows or HST units, let Phyllis know and she will print out patterns.

<u>To assemble</u> - refer to the diagram. (Note: at all times, fabric A is sewn to fabric B; never is fabric A sewn to fabric A, nor fabric B to fabric!)

- Sew 6 small HST units together to form the top row. (press to the dark)
- Do it again to form the bottom row.
- Sew 4 small HST units together to form the left side (press to the dark)
- Do it again to form the right side.
- Attach the sides to the large HST unit. Press to the large unit.
- Attach the top and bottom rows. Press wherever the seams want to go!
