Friendship Block #4 for Community Quilts

Initiated Feb 2013

These Friendship Block credits were donated to the Community Quilts program and Pam Beebe has selected the "Chariot Wheel" block, a traditional pieced block. She would like 12 of these blocks.

The block is 12-3/4" finished (13-1/4" unfinished)

Fabric:

8 print squares - these 3-1/2" squares of a blue car print are provided.

Background fabric - white or white-on-white or "reads as white" - cut 8 @ 3-1/2"

Sashing: One or more of the colors of the cars (red, green, yellow, aqua) - solid/reads as solid You will need 4 cut at 1-1/4" x 6-1/2" You may use a single fabric or 2 fabrics.

Center (cornerstone): One of the car colors that contrasts with the sashing Cut one @ 1-1/4" square.

Construction

A. Squares: combine the background and the blue print squares to make 4 - patch units. You will need 4 of these units. These units should measure 6-1/2" square.

B. Sashing: Referring to image, join two 4-patch units with a piece of sashing to form the left portion of the block. Repeat with the remaining two 4-patch units to form the right portion of the block. These portions should measure 6-1/2" x 13-1/4".

Join the remaining two pieces of sashing to opposite sides of the center/cornerstone. This unit should measure 1-1/4" x 13-1/4".

C. Assembly: Referring to the block image - combine these three units. Note: Make sure that the blue print squares are in the 4 outer corners.





You may pick up kits for this block from Phyllis at the meetings.

Please return completed block in a timely fashion, as all 12 are need to make the guilt top.
