

Friendship Block #5 for Community Quilts

Initiated Feb 2013

These Friendship Block credits were donated to the Community Quilts program and Pam Beebe has selected this traditional pieced block, Indian Star. She would like 12 of these blocks.



The block is **12" finished (12-1/2" unfinished)**

Fabric:

Colorful print - this fabric will be supplied (6 squares @ 3-1/2")

Background fabric - white or tone on tone white

Star: solid or "reads as solid" that picks out one of the colors in the print (Green/pink/gold/blue)

Construction - four-patch center, flying geese, corner squares

A. Center 4-patch: combine 2 of the print squares with 2 background squares cut @ 3-1/2"

B. Flying Geese: you will need 4 flying geese that finish at 3"x6" (unfinished 3-1/2" x 6-1/2")
Use your favorite method to make these, using background fabric for the large triangle shapes and your solid/reads-as-solid for the smaller triangle shapes.

C. Assembly: Assemble as per the illustration, paying attention to the orientation of the flying geese, so that you will see a star when the block is completed.

Row 1: print square + flying goose + print square

Row 2: flying goose + 4-patch + flying goose

Row 3: print square + flying goose + print square

Sew the three rows together.

You may pick up kits for this block from Phyllis at the meetings.

Please return completed block in a timely fashion, as all 12 are need to make the quilt top.
