Wedding Ring block for Jenine Giblin

Introduced Jun 2013

Jenine would love to have this block in pale golds. She is providing the background fabric, and would love to have you provide an assortment of gold fabrics.

Block Size: 10 " finished, 10-1/2" unfinished

Fabric: pre-washing is required.
Fabric A: background is provided
8 @ 3" squares
5 @ 2-1/2" squares

Fabric B: wedding ring: pale-medium gold tone on tone

2 squares @ 3"x 3"

4 squares @ 2-1/2" x 2-1/2"

Fabric C: 6 assorted very pale gold prints a single 3" square of each print



Instructions

Using Fabric A (2 of the 3" squares) and Fabric B (3" squares): place a pair of A and B squares right sides together with the light fabric on top. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the light fabric and stitch 1/4" away from the drawn line along both sides of the line. Cut apart on the drawn pencil line and press away from the background. You should have 4 of these A/B half square triangle units. TRIM to an accurate 2-1/2" square.


Using Fabric A (6 of the 3" squares) and Fabrics C (6 assorted fabric squares): repeat the same process as above, pairing up the A and C fabrics, to create 12 A/C half square triangle units. Press away from the background. TRIM to an accurate 2-1/2" square.

Following the block illustration, join squares together to form five horizontal rows.

NOTE: When you lay out the rows, make sure that the half-square triangles with fabric B are used in the center "ring", adjacent to the 4 squares that were cut from fabric B.

Press seams of each row in opposite directions.

Stitch the rows together to complete the block.
