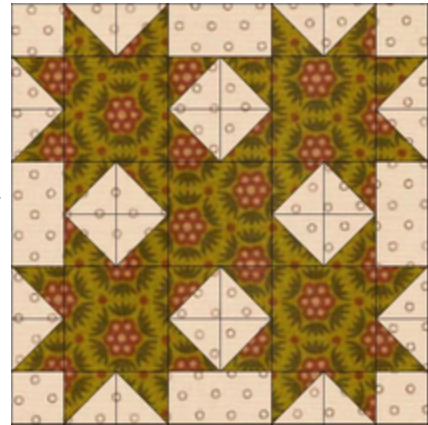


Devil's Claw Block for Susan Silvey

Susan is one of the lucky winners of our Friendship Block credit raffle and she has chosen an old classic called "Devil's Claw" - however, we have changed the construction so it is very much easier to assemble. Susan will be providing a fat quarter each of "claw" and background fabrics - please return the excess with your block. This block is 8" finished/ 8-1/2" unfinished.



Fabric Cutting - This pattern requires 36 half-square triangle units which should measure 1-1/2" each. You may make these using your favorite method, and what you cut will depend on your method.

You will need to cut the following from the lighter background fabric (but cut the fabric for your half-square triangles first): 4 @ 1-1/2" square 4 @ 1-1/2" x 2-1/2"

You will need to cut the following from the darker "claw" fabric (but cut the fabric for your half-square triangles first): 5 @ 2-1/2" square

Half-square triangles: This is an easy method if you don't have a favorite method:

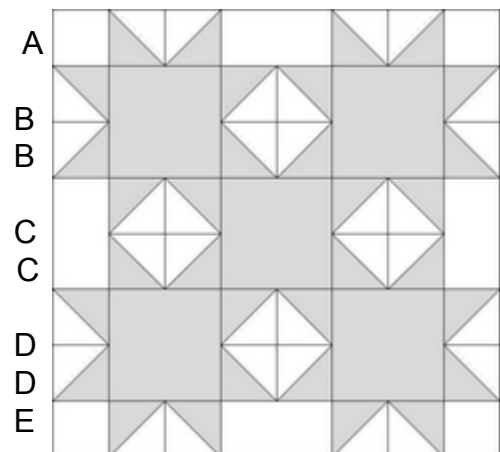
- Layer the two fabrics right sides together. Cut 2 strips 2" wide from the long side of the fabric. Cut these strips into 2" squares - you will need 16 squares.
- Position your pairs of squares with the light fabric right sides up. Draw a diagonal line on each square. Sew 1/4" from the drawn line on each side. Cut on the drawn line and press to the darker fabric. Trim each unit to 1-1/2" square. (32 units total)

Assembly: Here is the diagram for the completed block. You will be assembling it in 5 rows:

Row A/E
make 2

Row BB/DD:
make 2

Row CC:
