Friendship Block #10 for Community Quilts

For this Community Quilt friendship block Pam Beebe has selected the "Ribbon Quilt Block" block, a traditional pieced block. She would like 11 of these blocks to go with the sample she made.

The block is 9" finished (9-1/2" unfinished)

Fabric: The blue print fabric and the white fabric are supplied.

Construction - simple 9-patch with Half Square Triangle units.

A. Half Square Triangles Units - Place each 4" blue print square right sides together with a 4" white square. Mark the diagonal. Sew a <u>scant</u> guarter inch seam on each side of the diagonal. Cut on the diagonal.

Press to the blue print. You should end up with 8 half-square-triangle units. Trim each of these units to 3-1/2".

B. Assembly: Assemble these 8 units and the 3-1/2" white square so that the block looks like the image above. Pay particular attention to the orientation of the triangles. Wherever possible, press to the blue print. If you need to press to the white, you may need to grade the blue print seam allowance to avoid shadowing through the white fabric.

You may pick up kits for this block from Phyllis at the meetings.

Please return completed block in a timely fashion, as all are need to make the quilt top.



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
