

Friendship Block #9 for Community Quilts

Initiated Nov 2013

Pam Beebe has selected the "Stepping Stone" block, a traditional pieced block for this project. She would like 11 of these blocks to go with the sample she made.

The block is **12" finished (12-1/2" unfinished)**

Fabric: Blue print, gold and white fabrics are supplied.

Construction - Arrange the pre-cut squares and rectangles to match the diagram. Sew the first and last rows, pressing away from the white. Sew the four-patch in the center.



Make sure the gold fabrics are in upper left and lower right, then add a white rectangle to each side and press away from the white.

Assemble the block. You should see all the gold fabrics on one diagonal, and all the blue print fabrics on the other diagonal.

You may pick up kits for this block from Phyllis at the meetings.

Please return completed block in a timely fashion, as all 12 are need to make the quilt top.
