Angels for Tera

Think "Angels" for Tera! She has chosen many patterns which you may use in one of three ways: as an actual pattern, as a starting point which you may adapt/modify, or as inspiration for your own choice of block. There are quite a variety of patterns: applique, and paper foundation-pieced. You may also use a pattern of your own.

There are 4 files with images for your review: foundation paper pieced, applique, applique patterns by KP Pearson, and inspiration images. Two of these files are rather large and may take some time to load. (Or you may look at my copy at a meeting.) Let me know which one you want, and I will email the pattern to you.

Block size: 9" finished, 9-12" unfinished

These patterns have all been re-sized for Tera's block. If you choose another pattern and it needs to be re-sized, Phyllis will help enlarge/reduce. If you prefer to leave it smaller, you may put a border around it to bring it to size.

Fabric:

Please **pre-wash**, and do not use any scented dryer sheets or scented starch products, as Tera and her family are quite sensitive.

Fabrics need not be quilting cotton, but must be machine washable.

Background: think sky or sky and land (Any time of day...)

Angel: anything goes!

Foundation Pieced patterns: The 5 square patterns are lovely, and easy if you are already familiar with paper-piecing. The two rectangular patterns are fairly easy, even for novices. Note: If you choose any of these, please <u>do not trim the completed block</u>; Tera will take care of that. Please do remove the paper for her.

Applique patterns: Backgrounds may be single fabric or pieced. Please use a <u>10-1/2</u>" square for the background, but contain the applique within the center 8" of the square. Tera will trim to size. Any style applique is acceptable, but if you choose to fuse, please sew down all the edges.

Embellishments: Please make sure that embellishments are machine washable.

Blocks are "due" approximately a month after you sign up. We'd love to see them within at least 2 months! After that, I start nagging! (Phyllis)
