

Friendship Block #12 for Community Quilts

Initiated Jan 2014

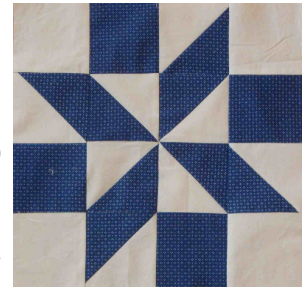
Pam Beebe has selected the "Shooting Star" block, a traditional pieced block. She would like 12 of these blocks.

The block is **12" finished (12-1/2" unfinished)**

Fabric:

All fabric has been provided: 4 small squares (3-1/2") and 4 large squares (4") of each of 2 fabrics.

Construction - Combine the squares and Half Square Triangle (HST) units as shown in the photo.



Half Square Triangles Units - use the large squares

Place one of each fabric right sides together, mark a diagonal, and sew 1/4" on each side of the marked diagonal. Cut on the diagonal. Press towards the dark blue fabric. Repeat with the remaining squares. Trim these 8 units to 3-1/2" - should be the same size as the small squares.

Assembly: Press to the red print fabric.

Row 1 - 2 white squares, 1 blue square, and 1 HST - sewn in a row as in the photo. Make 2

Row 2 - 1 blue square, 3 HST - sewn in a row as in the photo. Make 2

Row 3 - rotate one of the Row 2 strips until it matches the photo.

Row 4 - rotate one of the Row 1 strips until it matches the photo.

Sew the 4 rows together to match the photo

You may pick up kits for this block from Phyllis at the meetings.

Please return completed block in a timely fashion, as all 12 are need to make the quilt top.
