Pam Beebe has selected the "Squares Upon Squares" block. She would like 18 sets of these blocks.


The block is 6" finished (6-1/2" unfinished) and each set is 2 blocks.

Fabric:

4 fabrics have been provided: yellow print, white, and 2 greens.

Construction:

Look carefully at the photo and you will see that the two blocks are not identical: the left block has the darker



Upper half of blocks

- Step 1: Sew yellow rectangle to light green rectangle; sew yellow rectangle to dark green rectangle. (Row 1 in the photos)
- Sew small yellow square and light green square to the ends of white rectangle; sew small yellow square and dark green square to ends of white rectangle. (Row 2 in the photos)
- Step 3: Sew Row 1 to Row 2, to match the photos, paying attention to the green fabrics.

Lower half of blocks

- Sew dark green square to white square; press; sew to dark green rectangle should match lower Step 1: left guarter of the photo on the left. Repeat with the light green fabric, to match lower left guarter of the photo on the right.
- Step 2: Add large yellow square to each of these units to match the photo.

Assemble

Sew upper half to lower half, matching the photos. Make sure that the light greens and dark greens are in the right positions, so that the secondary pattern will emerge when the blocks are combined.

You may pick up kits for this block from Phyllis at the meetings.

Please return completed block in a timely fashion, as all are need to make the quilt top.
