

Please pick five fabrics. First pick a focus fabric. This should be a WOW print or pick one that you can do appliqué or embroidery on later.

Focus fabric – cut one 16 ½” square (you will lose a couple of inches off each corner when it is set into the middle of the quilt).

Primary color – cut one 11” square, cut one 9 ½” square, cut four 5” squares.

Lighter shade of primary color – cut one 9 ½” square and eight 4 ½” squares

Dark (or medium dark) Contrast – (pick a complimentary color to the primary fabric) cut two 11” squares

Neutral (background) – cut one 11” square, cut two 9 ½” squares, and cut four 5” squares

Please pre-cut fabric and bring your remnants. This makes a 32” quilt top. Fabric is not included for borders. You could use more of your focus fabric or other fabrics. Please bring sewing machine, 12” or bigger mat (revolving mat is great), 18” ruler or longer, 6” square ruler or bigger, “Quilt in a Day” Flying Geese ruler (large size 4”x 8”) if you have one – otherwise we will share, rotary cutter, extension cord, iron, etc. I will bring the chocolate and the instruction sheet.

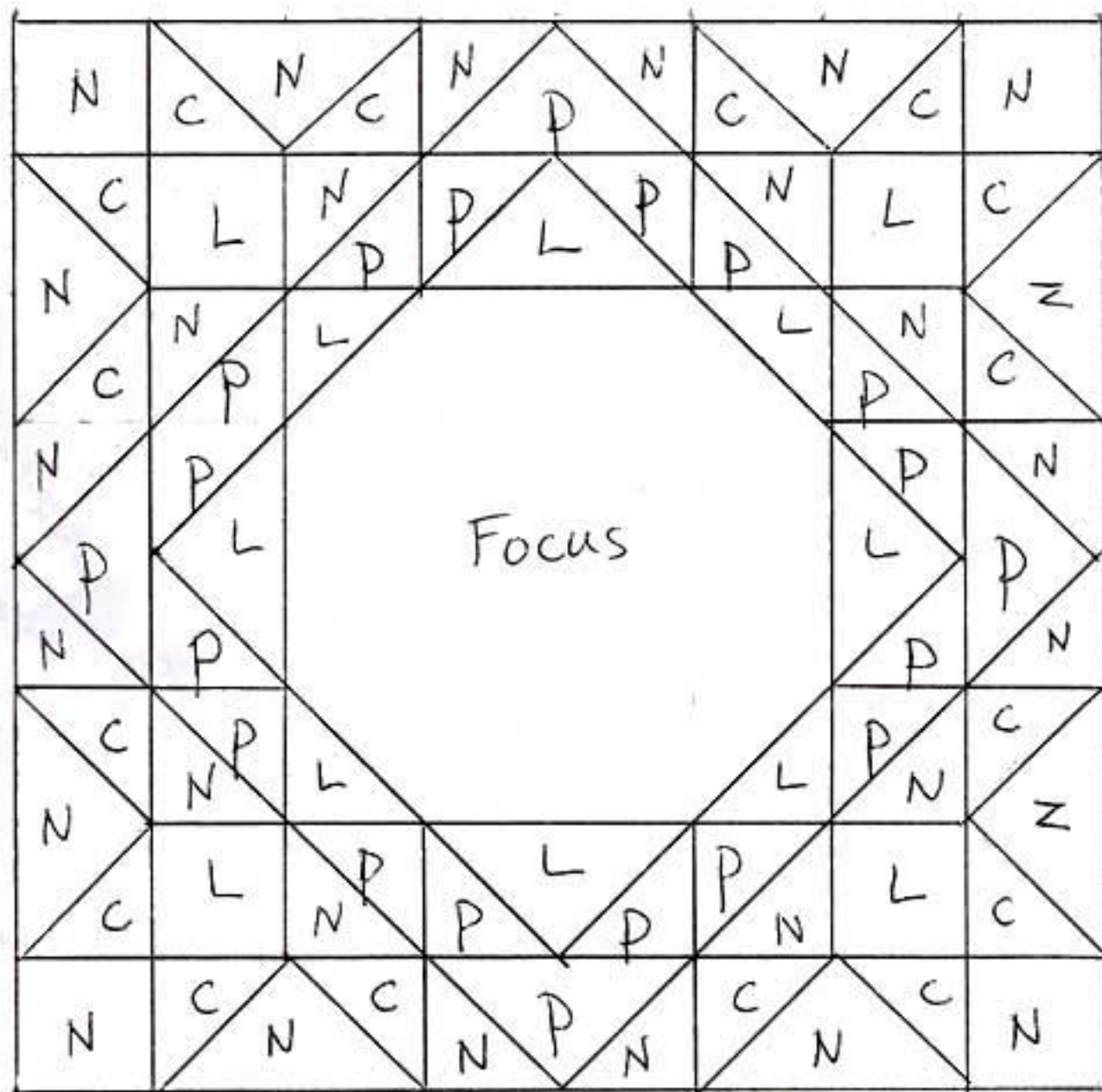

Mystery Quilt Revealed

- 1. Use the 4 ½” squares of light fabric (L). Draw diagonal line on back of each. Pin right sides together to each corner of 16 ½” square. Sew one thread to the outside of the line. Press out. Flip back and trim off excess.**
- 2. Use 5” squares of Primary (P) and neutral (N). Place two right sides together. Draw diagonal line. Sew ¼” on both sides of the line. Press to set. Cut apart. Press open to the dark side. Should finish at 4 ½”.**
- 3. Make flying geese units by following the instructions that come with the ruler.**
 - Use 1 light (L) 9 ½” square with 1 Primary (P) 11” square.**
 - Use 1 primary (P) 9 ½” square with 1 neutral (N) 11” square.**
 - Use 2 neutral (N) 9 ½” squares with 2 contrast (C) 11” squares.**
- 4. Follow diagram and assemble rows. Piece quilt top. Layer quilt and bind. Pat yourself on the back and then take a nap! :)**

Focus = $16\frac{1}{2}$ square

Light = cut one = $9\frac{1}{2}$ " square, cut 8 - $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

Primary = cut two = 11" squares, cut one = $9\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
cut four = 5" squares

Contrast = cut two = 11" squares
neutral - cut one = 11" sq., two = $9\frac{1}{2}$ " squares;
cut four = 5" sq., cut four = $4\frac{1}{2}$ " sq.
