Mystery Quilt 2015

Instruction Sheet #2



This is the last set of instructions to be finished at home before the class on September 3rd.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the light 4" or 3 7/8" squares.

Place the light square on top of the dark 4" or 3 7/8" square right sides together.

Sew a scant ¼ "seam on each side of marked line. Cut apart on marked line to make a half square triangle, (HST).

Press seams open. Square up each unit to $3\frac{1}{2}$ ". (If you chose the "Very Confident Sewer" cutting instructions, your blocks should already be $3\frac{1}{2}$ " and should not require squaring up.)

You should have 48 HST's total.







Draw a diagonal line on your dark 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Set these aside so they will be ready on the day of the class.

You are now ready for the Mystery Quilt Class on September 3rd. The class will start approximately ½ hour after the meeting.

Please bring your sewing machines, basic supplies and rotary cutter. Other helpful items would be a small cutting mat, a travel iron and a 12 ½" square ruler for squaring up your units.
