You'll be constructing two sets of blocks for the mystery quilt this month.

A: Mosaic Blocks

Required precut Pieces

| Background | Eight 2 1/8" x 2 1/8"; Two 7 3/8" triangles | Sixteen 2 1/8" x 2 1/8"; Four 7 3/8" triangles | | |

| Leaves 2 | Five 2 1/8" x 2 1/8" | Ten 2 1/8" x 2 1/8" | | |
| Solid 1 | Six 2 1/8 " x 2 1/8" | Twelve 2 1/8 " x 2 1/8" | | |
| Solid 4 | Two 3/4" x 14" | Four 3/4" x 14" | | |

- 1) Arrange the 2 1/8" squares in this order:
- 2) Sew each row together, pressing seams alternately so when you sew rows together the seams will nest.




3) Sew the rows together, press the seams open.





4) Sew a 7 3/8" triangle to each corner. Align the long side of the triangle 1/4" seam line along the points of the leaves square corners. Sew a quarter inch seam. Trim off points and press the seam towards the triangle. Repeat for other corner.



5) Cut the square diagonally through the 6 solid squares.





6) Lastly, baste on the flange along each diagonal edge. Recommend running the basting stitch at 1/8". Trellis blocks - make 10 - label as Side 2





B) Trellis blocks - make 12 - label as Side 3

1) **Quarter Square Triangles**:With RST, sew Fabric A & Fabric D triangles together (short side) and Fabric C & Fabric B triangles together (short side). Press seams in opposite directions. Stitch the two sections together (center seam). Press seam open.



2) **Trim blocks to 4.5" X 4.5" squares. IMPORTANT**: Make sure center point is in the middle of the block - you will be trimming approximately the same amount on all 4 sides.
