 - Ticket cost will be \$50.00; no reservation will be taken without a check payment and a filled out Liability Release form.

- Glenda Ross announced that she has a full slate of members to work the Fall Home and Garden Show. The quilt has been earning money everywhere it is displayed.

- Judith Clarke thanked members for attending the Habitat for Humanity Quilt Show recently and noted that the need for quilts is greater as Habitat is now buying existing homes instead of building new homes. The quilters supporting Habitat meet at Village Sewing Center on the first Tuesday of each month and all are welcome.

- Friendship Blocks--Phyllis Gallaway reported are still going well, but that only one block has openings—Linda Ziemer's. Numerous people have more than 20 credits and Phyllis will start reminding them to submit ideas for blocks they would like to receive. She also displayed one block for Linda Ziemer and one for Justine Lott.
- Electric Quilt Club--Phyllis Gallaway announced that the EQ Club will meet again on Thursday, September 13th at Village Sewing Center. Jan Andrews will present a demonstration on tracing using EQ7.
- Guild Retreat--Phyllis reported that she has not yet received confirmation from the Presbyterian Center confirming our retreat dates for 2013.
- Block of the Month--Joyce Wood noted that due to Veline Ball's absence, she would not be singing. The August block had great participation, but she has one block without a name and if no one claims it, she will assume that it is for Community Quilts. Joyce presented the September block, a Log Cabin that is modified to look like a sailboat.
- Community Quilts--Pam Beebe announced a work party at her home on Thursday, September 13th to work on kits for Valley of the Moon quilts. Attendees should bring a sack lunch. The final Quiltathon of the year will be held on October 4th. Community Quilts has hundreds of quilts to be quilted, and Pam encouraged members to bring their sewing machines that day. Pam also displayed a Wounded Warrior quilt that she completed on Elaine Tucker's long arm machine. Pam did not know who made the blocks and would like members to advise her when turning in completed quilts.
- Sew-A-Row—Ellindale Wells displayed several of the completed Sew-A-Rows from our 2012 program. She will be accepting starter rows for 2013 between now and until the end of January 2013.
- Programs and Workshops--Linda Hooper and Linda Ziemer displayed a sample for the October workshop with Lyn Mann. Lyn's rulers will be available at the workshop and many fabric styles will work with the design.
- Opportunity Quilt Tickets--Rhonda Denny urged members to both purchase and sell tickets for Santa Rosa Beauty.
- Bulb Sale Fundraiser--Jan Andrews passed around the clipboards for bulb sales and reminded members that sales will close at the next meeting.
