

November Block of the Month

Rabbit's Foot

Blocks are due December 7

Make it in a white on white print for background A and red solid for fabric B
Make another block for Community Quilts in your choice of color.

Cutting instructions:

From fabric A (background) cut:

Five 4 1/2" by 4 1/2" squares

Four 2 1/2" by 2 1/2" squares

Six 3" by 3" squares

From fabric B (red) cut:

Four 2 1/2" by 2 1/2" squares

Six 3" by 3" squares

Sewing instructions:

- To make half square triangles:**
Draw a line on the wrong side of each 3" by 3" square of fabric A. Pair a 3" by 3" square of fabric A with a 3" by 3" square of fabric B. SEW A QUARTER INCH SEAM ON BOTH SIDES OF LINE. Trim on line. Press seams to dark. Make twelve half square triangles. These are oversize. Trim to 2 1/2" by 2 1/2."
- To make corner units:** Following diagram, sew three half square triangles of one 2 1/2" square of fabric A.
- To make center unit:** Draw a line on the wrong side of four 2 1/2" by 2 1/2" square of fabric B. Place a 2 1/2" square of fabric B on the edge of a 4 1/2" by 4 1/2" square of fabric A. SEW ON LINE. Press corner to corner. Trim away bottom two layers. Repeat on opposite corner. Trim away bottom two layers. Repeat steps on remaining two corners.
- Following diagram sew units together with plain 4 1/2" by 4 1/2" squares.
