Block Name: Festive Evergreen Tree
Finished Size: 10" square

Fabric A: Background, Cream with gold flecks

TEN squares, 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" ; TWO strips, 2-1/2" x 3-1/2"
 TWO strips, 2-1/2" x 1-1/2" ; TWO strips, 2-1/2" x 4-1/2"

Fabric B: Four Assorted Greens

ONE strip, 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" ; ONE strip, 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" ;
 ONE strip, 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" ; ONE strip, 2-1/2" x 10-1/2"

Fabric C: Mottled Brown

One square, 2-1/2" x 2-1/2"

Assemble the green strips and eight of the 2-1/2" background squares. Draw a diagonal line on each of the eight 2-1/2" background squares. Place a square on the end of the 4-1/2" green strip, right sides together, being sure to position the drawn line as shown. Stitch on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam. Fold up and press toward the background. Sew another square to the opposite end of the green strip. Trim, fold up and press. Repeat to sew corners on the remaining three green strips. Stitch a 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" background strip to each side of the brown square. Arrange the block components as shown in the following diagram. Stitch together to form five 10-1/2" rows, and press. Join rows together to create:
