October Block of the Month

Capital T

Blocks are due November 2, 2006

Make block in white on white background and a bold black and white print for figure. Make it in bright or pastel prints for the Community Quilts Project. Choose your own color scheme for the sampler block.

Cutting instructions:

From fabric A background:

Cut two 3" by 3"squares Cut eight 2 ½" by 4 ½" rectangles From fabric B (black): Cut two 3" by 3" squares Cut sixteen 2 ½" by 2 ½" rectangles

Cut one 41/2" x 41/2" square

Sewing instructions:

- Draw a line diagonally on wrong side of fabric A, pair with a square of fabric B. With wrong sides together SEW A QUARTER INCH SEAM ON BOTH SIDES OF LINE. Trim on line. Press triangles open with seams to dark. These are oversize. Square up to 4 ½" by 4 ½".
- 2. To make a flying geese unit: Draw a diagonal line from upper left corner to lower right corner on each dark Fabric B 2 ½" by 2 ½" square. Place a square with right sides together on a corner of one of the light 2 ½" by 4 ½" rectangles. SEW ON LINE. Trim away underlying two layers. Press towards corner. Repeat with other corner. Repeat above steps until you have eight flying geese units.
- Sew flying geese units together in tandem. Repeat until you have four geese in tandem units.
- Following diagram, sew corner units to center units in rows.
