Rooster Class Supply List and Pre Class Instructions

Supplies needed

1 fat quarter for center/background fabric

1/8 yard fabric for inner border

1/8 yard fabric for middle border

1/2 yard fabric for outer border

1/3 yard fabric for rooster body

Small piece of red fabric for the wattle

Small piece of yellow/orange fabric for feet and beak

Several small pieces of "busy" fabric in various colors for the feathers

(see Fabric Selection)

1/2 yard of fustible web (Steam-A-Seam Lite, Wonder Under.....)

Scissors

Threads

Pins

Cutting board, cutting ruler, rotary cutter

Sewing machine

Pencils

Applique pressing sheet

Iron+protective cover

Batting 32" x 40"

Backing fabric 32" x 40"

Fabric selection

As the feathers are assembled, small pieces of fabric will be cut. In selecting fabrics choose designs that will "do the work". Fabric patterns which read as stripes work best. The print can be stripes, plaids, flowers, polka dots...the key is the patterns are in rows, hence, read as stripes.

Before the Class

If you make the frame ahead of time (the center piece with the borders) you will be able to start the rooster straight away and will not need your sewing machine, batting and backing. Cut first and middle border pieces 1.5" and outer border 3.5". A demo will be given for tips on quilting.
