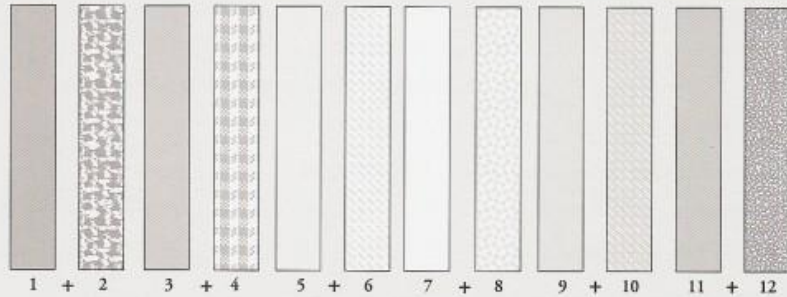


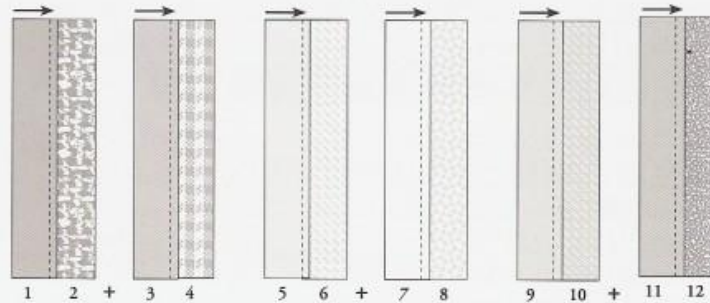
CREATING STRATA UNITS

Refer to the numbers on your fabric chart and sew the strips together as shown below. See “Sewing and Pressing” on page 24 for more about strata construction.

Begin by sewing the strips, right sides together, in pairs: strip #1 to strip #2, strip #3 to strip #4, and so on, as indicated by the plus signs between the strips. Remember to maintain consistent $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances.

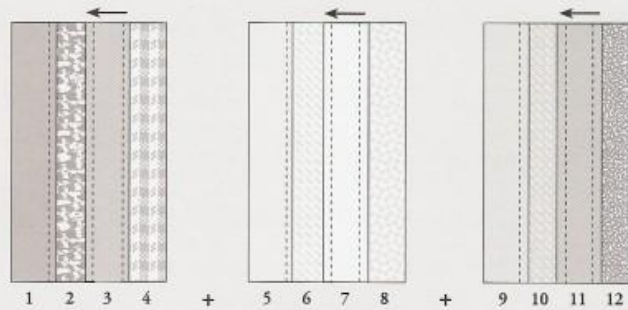


As strips are sewn, press the seams toward the even-numbered fabrics, as indicated by the arrows above each pair.



Now sew the pairs together (#1/#2 to #3/#4, and so on) as indicated by the plus signs between the pairs.

As pairs are sewn into groups of four, press the new seams toward the even-numbered fabrics, as indicated by the arrows above each group.



Now sew the groups together, as indicated by the plus signs between the groups.

When the groups have been sewn together to complete the strata unit, press the new seams toward the even-numbered fabrics, as indicated by the arrows above the unit. (Only the even-numbered fabrics will have seam allowances under them.)
