Supply List for Workshop



Prior to the workshop:

- ◆ NY Pattern: Choose and purchase your handbag pattern \$12.00 (reg. \$15.00).
- ◆ **Please Cut out your pattern** in the fashion fabric and lining including the pocket(s), if you are doing them. This allows all of us to start together.

One stop shopping:

Poozles handbag patterns, kits and handbag making hardware will be available for purchase at the workshop. Pamela will have: specialty handbag making supplies such as her Poozles heavy stabilizer that won't crease when pulled through a 5' opening, 18 MM clasps and matching handbag feet available in *four colors* – *Antique Brass, Brass, Nickel and Hematite (black)*, various handbag handles, hard bottoms in 9 sizes with four pre-drilled holes for the handbag feet to go through, stabilizers, fusible interfacing, and more.

Bring with you the day of the workshop:

- ◆ **Reminder – Please have your fabrics cut out prior to the workshop.** I know you don't need me to show you how to cut out fabric—LOL. My goal is for you to complete your purse during the workshop.
- ◆ *Fusible interfacing for the pockets* – I recommend woven fusible interfacing.
- ◆ *Basic sewing supplies* - ruler, markers, threads, hand needle, pins, scissors, tube turners for handles, etc. – the usual suspects.
- ◆ *Sewing machine* – if you have a choice, bring the machine that can handle fabric, lining and stabilizer all at once. The New Yorker is NOT suitable for light weight, feather weight or traveler machines. Sewing machine needles – **size 14 & 16 topstitch or sharp** for sewing with the heavier stabilizer and whatever size you need for sewing your lining.

Lunch – I like to take about ½ hour break. I recommend you bring your lunch.
