Printing Fabric Workshop

There will be a \$9.00 materials fee for the paint, which is provided. I will also have a few goodies for you. Please pay instructor directly (note from Phyllis: exact change is helpful)

MATERIALS LIST:

Design Sources - your favorite book or collection of photos for design ideas. A **good**

plan is to pick a theme so you can create designs around it.

Fabric - 8 fat quarters prewashed of white or light solid colors or batiks or

small prints. You may find you want more, so bring some extra.

Clear or white plastic - - drop cloth weight and large enough to fit under your fat quarter.

Cotton Batting - large enough to fit under your plastic, these two together make a

simple printing surface

Scrap paper and tracing paper- to work out your designs

Sponges - another means of applying paint - can bring different sizes & types.

Paper Towels - for clean-up, can use a rag instead

Palette and palette knife - to mix colors, clean TV dinner trays and a dinner knife work too

Pencil - soft No. 2

Stencil brushes - both a small and a fat sized one are good to have.

Xacto knife and cutting mat- a small Olfa mat or a piece of cardboard

Vegetables & knife - cabbage, celery, squash, fruits or any others you want to try.

Rubber stamps - ones with simple shapes and deep impressions

Objects with interesting designs in relief like baby blocks

Found objects - look around you for things, which may print well. From your sewing

studio you can bring: empty spools, beeswax holder, presser feet,

buttons, thimble, bobbins, etc.

Scissors

Masking Tape

Water Jar - plastic preferred for safety

Plastic to cover your table -you can plan to wash the table as paint cleans up easily

Plastic or rubber gloves - if you do not want paint on your hands.

Needed – but I have some to share:

Flat 1" wide paintbrush

Speedball Linoleum Block cutting tools

Brayer

Leaves - Japanese maple is especially pretty, or any interesting shape

Pentel fabric crayons

Saran Wrap – Original if you can find it
